Master cylinder*

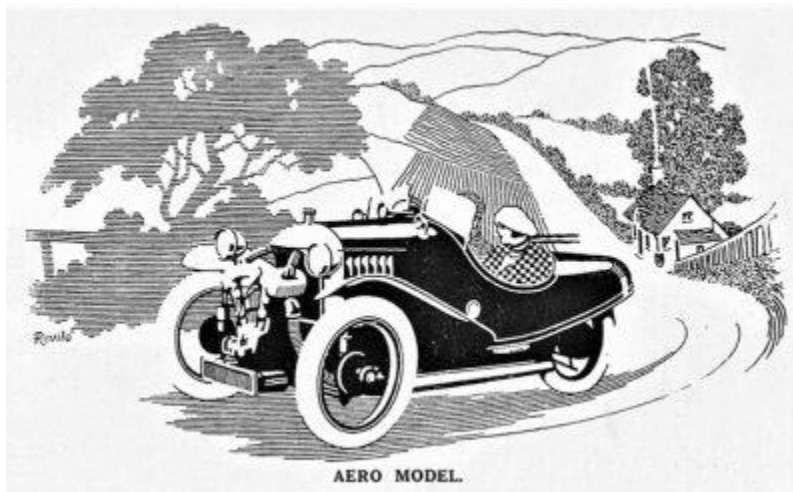
2.A Haiku in Honor of Morgan Ancestry
